We want to make sure all of our families know about the **extra benefits available through Sunshine Health**. If your child or caregiver is enrolled with Sunshine Health, you may qualify for **free or low-cost YMCA programs**, including swim lessons, memberships, and childcare support.

Below is a quick overview of what's available.

Caregiver Swim Lessons (Adults 18+)

- Sunshine Health caregivers can receive **up to 8 group swim lessons** at their local YMCA.
- If you live in an area without a YMCA, a **local swim vendor** may be used instead.
- To sign up, simply **show your Sunshine Health member ID** at the YMCA front desk.

Children's Swim Lessons (Under 21)

- Children and teens can receive **one full group swim session (up to 8 lessons)** at the YMCA.
- If no YMCA is nearby, a **local swim vendor** may be used.
- Bring your **Sunshine Health member ID** to register.

YMCA Membership

- Sunshine Health covers up to **\$150 per year** toward a YMCA membership for an individual or a family of four.
- Membership includes access to YMCA facilities and the **Y360 virtual platform**.
- Members must visit the YMCA **at least once a month** to keep the benefit active.
- Ages 16–17 must have a parent or guardian present.
- Sign up by showing your **member ID** at the YMCA front desk.

Childcare Support

- Sunshine Health offers **one week of YMCA childcare or after-school care** for eligible members.
- This benefit is for members **16+ who have a child under 18** and are enrolled in **Care Management**.
- If there is no YMCA in your area, a **local childcare provider** may be used instead.
